



**BRUCE MECKLER APPOINTED TO  
JUDICIAL INQUIRY BOARD**

(CHICAGO, NOVEMBER 3, 2009)...Attorney **Bruce R. Meckler** has been appointed by Illinois Governor Pat Quinn to the state's nine-member **Judicial Inquiry Board**. Meckler's four-year term is effective immediately.

Meckler, co-chair of the law firm of Meckler Bulger Tilson Marick & Pearson, will serve as a legal member of the Board – which is composed of three lawyers, four non-lawyers and two judges.

The Judicial Inquiry Board investigates and prosecutes allegations of judicial misconduct or incapacity against active Illinois state court judges – reviewing complaints, determining if an investigation is appropriate and which matters will be prosecuted before the Courts Commission.
